school holiday, a bunch of kids from Madikwe (about 90km from Rustenburg) went for a swim in a stream flowing into the Tholwane River on Friday 7 January.

While most of the kids just played on the riverbank, a 9-year-old boy who played in the water, was swept downstream by the strong current, due to recent rains. His riverbank, about 8 kilometres downstream friends immediately sounded the alarm. The Madikwe police, Hartbeespoort Dam's National Sea Rescue Institute (NSRI), and the Uitkyk village Strategic Rescue Unit (SRU) attended the scene.

They braved the Tholwane River but the search had to be called off, only to resume the following morning as it was getting too dark to continue.

The search was extended downstream,

> The search efforts were hampered by the swollen river and the remote and barely accessible terrain. Community members also joined the search operation.


> At approximately 17h30, members of the Police Air Wing spotted the boy on the from where the children were swimming. Emergency personnel were sent in, who found that the child died.

> "A judicial inquest into the cause of death is underway," said Rustenburg Police captain Elsabé Augoustides. The body of the boy was sent to the Government Health Forensic Pathology Services.

N4 claims four lives





MEC for Community Safety and Transport Management for the North West, Sello Lehari thanked emergency service personnel and law enforcement agencies who attended to the scene. He reached out to the loved ones of the deceased and said: "I pray that you are strengthened in this tough time. Please accept my sincere condolences.

Rustenburg - Four people died following a collision involving three vehicles along the N4 highway between Rustenburg Mall and the Kroondal offramp on Saturday 8 January. A culpable homicide case has been opened. Says ER24 spokesperson Russel Meiring: "ER24 and other emergency services arrived at 20h25 to find two vehicles on the road and a third in the veld. Upon closer inspection, medics found a man and a woman lying trapped and motionless inside the small bakkie, trapped. Unfortunately, both had already succumbed to their injuries."

Trauma Rescue general manager Wentzel Dippenaar told Platinum Weekly: "Besides the two in the Nissan NP200 bakkie, Trauma Rescue and paramedics on scene were provided with advanced life support interventions and were transported to hospital."

Sadly, two more people involved in this accident succumbed to their injuries in hospital, bringing the total to four lives lost. We extend our sincerest condolences to the loved ones of the deceased.



Community member help to get murder suspect arrested

Mogwase – A 27-year-old murder suspect was arrested in Mogwase while boarding a taxi to Rustenburg on Friday 17 December.

He was arrested for allegedly stabbing a man with a knife in the neck during a fight. The victim succumbed to his wounds and was certified dead upon arrival at a local hospital.

Police spokesperson lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani said the suspect, his girlfriend and the victim were spotted at a local tavern the night before until the early morning hours of 17 December.

Said Funani: "The trio left the tavern and went to the suspect's house where a fight allegedly ensued between the victim and the suspect. During the fight, the suspect reportedly drew a knife and stabbed the victim, after which he fled the scene with his girlfriend."

Funani added that the victim was seen by a passer-by who alerted the police.

"We managed to trace the suspect and his girlfriend as they were about to board a taxi to Rustenburg," Funani concluded. Investigations continue.

MAN RAPES **WIFE AFTER** DOUSING HER IN PETROL...?

Mogwase – A 41-year-old man accused of assaulting and strangling his wife with a rope and then pouring petrol on her before raping her, appeared before the Mogwase Magistrates' Court for a third time on Monday 10 January. Oupa Nkele faces charges of assault with grievous bodily harm and rape.

Nkele is expected back in the same court on Monday 17 January after his Legal Aid attorney requested a postponement to consult with him. NPA spokesperson Henry Mamothame said the state has established that the accused collected his wife from her parents' home on 29 December after she had agreed to meet with him to discuss urgent personal matters. "He then drove towards a local mall but changed direction and went to their house in Lerome village near Mogwase," Mamothame said.

"An argument reportedly ensued after the pair arrived at their home. Nkele allegedly assaulted and strangled his wife with a rope, doused her with petrol before eventually raping her. He then allegedly forced her into his car and drove off. His wife managed to unlock her car door and jumped from the moving vehicle to escape from him," he added. Mamothame said the woman received assistance from a concerned member of the community who accompanied her to the police station to lay charges.

Nkele was arrested the following day.

WOMAN CONFESSES TO HIRING HITMEN TO KILL FAMILY

Brits - A woman who confessed to being the mastermind of a hit on her parents and siblings six years ago, will appear before the Brits Magistrates' Court on Thursday 13 January. The woman, who allegedly committed the crime in December 2016 while she was still 16 years old, will appear before the court with the two alleged hitmen. National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) spokesperson Lumka Mahanjana told Platinum Weekly that the trio will apply for bail during their appearance.

Police spokesperson lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani said the arrests were made in December 2021 after the woman went to Mmakau police station and admitted to killing her family members.

On that fateful day,

Tuesday 6 December 2016...

According to the 2016 police report, the mastermind suspect, then 16 years old, went outside to dispose of the water she used to wash dishes. She apparently heard gunshots and run inside when she also got shot - in the thigh. The suspects fled the scene with the family's car, a Chrysler Voyager. The daughter then alerted neighbours who called the police.

• Four murders were committed that day.

The lifeless bodies of her father (the then 42-year-old police officer), his 40-year-old wife, their 18-year-old pregnant daughter as well as a six-year-old boy were all found lying in a pool of blood. The woman and the two alleged hitmen - both aged 23 - are facing five counts of murder and armed robbery.

Suicide to evade murder trial?

Rustenburg – A 41-year-old man accused of stabbing and killing his wife's friend, attempted to take his own life by drinking poison. Simphiwe Nqakaqa appeared before the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court on Wednesday 22 December on charges of murder.

Police spokesperson lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani said the suspect's wife and her friend allegedly found him trying to commit suicide by drinking poison on 11 December 2021.

"The wife and the friend questioned the accused about drinking the poison. Out of anger, the accused allegedly stabbed his wife's 31-year-old friend with a knife in the upper body," Funani said. "The victim was transported to a local hospital where she was certified dead."

Nqakaqa was also transported to hospital after he drank even more poison.







A CLOUDY START TO THE YEAR

Hartebeespoort Dam – While talks of a new aquatic weed that threatens to suffocate Hartbeespoort Dam is in the spotlight, residents and tourists enjoyed the views of the Hartebeespoort Dam sluices that were opened this weekend.

South Africa's recent rainfall was widespread and many towns were flooded.

When the Crocodile River (West) crosses into the North West, it feeds two large dams in the river; the Hartbeespoort Dam and Roodekoppies Dam. On 10 January, the Department of Water and Sanitation measured Hartbeespoort Dam at 96.5% full, while all North West dams, on average, are 75% full.

Did you know?

After the news that the Hartebeespoort Dam would never fully be ridded of the invasive water hyacinth, a new pesky species of plant has proven to be equally difficult to control. According to Invasive Species South Africa (ISSA), the small salvinia (*Salvinia minima*) officially became Hartebeespoort Dam's 'secondary invasion' aquatic weed in May 2021.





NSFAS applications deadline extended to 21 Jan 2022



SA - The National Student Financial Aid Scheme (NSFAS) was established in 1991 by the South African government to provide financial aid to eligible students from poor and working-class families. It provides fully subsidised funding for poor and working-class students at public universities.

The bursary covers full cost of study, including tuition, registration, learning material, meal allowance, accommodation or travel allowance, and personal care allowance.

After consulting with various stakeholders, NSFAS extended the deadline for applications for the student financial aid to Friday 21 January 2022. The previous deadline was Friday 7 January 2022. The application process opened on 2 November 2021 and to date, more than 600,000 applications were received. At least 505,820 are first-time applicants.

Potential applicants are urged to make use of this opportunity as there will no further extension on the application deadline.

To qualify for NSFAS funding, you must be:

- · A South African citizen,
- SASSA grant recipients (the SASSA Covid-19 grant does not count),
- Persons whose combined household income is not more than R350,000 per year,
- Persons living with disabilities with a combined household income not more than R600,000 per annum,
- A permanent resident an individual who is in possession of a valid permanent residency permit issued by the Department of Home Affairs in South Africa.


