Bakkie crashed through wall at Rusoord

Rustenburg - Shortly before midnight on Thursday evening 3 February, a Toyota Hilux crashed through the boundary wall of Rustenburg Rusoord. "It sounded like a plane landed on our roof," says Marietjie van Zyl who stays at Rustenburg Rusoord with her grandson Christiaan Goosen. Goosen told Platinum Weekly that he at first thought that it was a tree that fell on the wall: "When I went outside, I saw that it was a bakkie that went through the wall, about 5 metres from my grandmother's bedroom. If that wall didn't stop the bakkie, it would have gone right through her bedroom wall." According to preliminary reports, the bakkie swerved off the road, flattened a signboard and scraped past two trees before crashing through the wall. Of the three occupants, the driver and one of the passengers sustained serious injuries, while the other (female) passenger passed away at the scene.

Being right across the street from the Job Shimankana Tabane hospital, an ambulance arrived at the scene within minutes.

Rustenburg - Scorebet, located at the Biblio Plaza Shopping Centre in Nelson Mandela Drive fell victim to armed robbers on Thursday 3 February.

The suspects parked their white Ford Focus in front of the shop. Just as the doors opened that morning, three suspects entered



Criminals spotted in tree

Derby - For the past few months, Derby has been plagued with crimes from housebreaking to burglaries and assault. Reverend Etienne Ferreira fell victim to two criminals who broke into his garage shortly before 02h00 on Wednesday 2 February. He immediately reported it to the neighbourhood watch and iProtect Security Services, who responded swiftly. SIX MONTHS HOUSE ARREST FOR STATUTORY RAPE

Rustenburg - A 20-year-old man from Lefaragatlha will spend six months under house arrest after he was convicted of statutory rape by the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court on Monday 31 January 2022.

 Statutory rape refers to sexual relations involving someone below the "age of consent". People who are underage cannot legally consent to having sex, so any form of sexual activity with them violates the law. The age of consent in South Africa is 17.

Alfred Shongwane was sentenced to three years in prison for statutory rape following an incident in which he had sexual relations with a 13-year-old girl on 31 January 2021 (exactly a year earlier).

However, the sentence was suspended on condition that Shongwane does not commit a similar offence during the six months he will be under house arrest.

Rustenburg police spokesperson sergeant Ofentse Mokgadi said Shongwane had an affair with the 13-year-old girl after the two had met through social media. "Shongwane went with the girl to his parent's house in Lefaragatlha and spent the night with her on 31 January 2021," sergeant Mokgadi said.

He walked with the girl to her parent's home the following day. The girl informed the parents about the incident and investigations by sergeant Phenyo Monchusi led to the arrest of Shongwane. Irrefutable evidence produced in court resulted in Shongwe being convicted.

R7,000 bribe lands cop in hot water



Tlhabane/ Rustenburg - A 34-year-old policeman appeared before the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court in Tlhabane on Monday 7 February on charges of corruption. Constable Lawrence Sebole stands accused of soliciting a R7,000 bribe from a man implicated in an incident of stock theft. Sebole was remanded in custody until his next appearance on Friday 11 February.

He was arrested on 4 February in Phokeng after allegedly accepting cash from a man as a bribe. This man, implicated in an incident of stock theft in January, appeared in court before his case was withdrawn to allow for further investigations

National Prosecuting Authority (NPA) spokesperson for the North West, Henry Mamothame said Sebole reportedly accepted the bribe to "release a vehicle that was impounded and stored in the police exhibit yard".

Sebole's future with the police force is not yet clear following his court appearance. Police spokesperson colonel Adéle Myburgh said internal SAPS investigations into the matter are underway.

The SAPS Anti-Corruption Investigation Unit (ACIU) is investigating.

Rustenburg - ARustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) special council meeting held on Friday 4 February 2022 was disrupted by a group of community members. Proceedings inside the council chambers at the Rustenburg Civic Centre were halted as the noisy group called for the removal of Marikana ward 31 councillor Vuyiswa Shomang. A video of the incident, which is circulating on social media, shows the group shouting for the removal of the councillor. RLM spokesperson Thapelo Matebesi said that a councillor was taken to hospital for treatment after sustaining injuries during the mayhem. "The Speaker of Council (councillor Koketso Mogomotsi) will institute formal investigations to get to the bottom of what could have prompted this unexpected interruption," Matebesi said.

A NIGHT OUT ENDS IN HOSPITA

Rustenburg - On Friday evening 4 February just before midnight, a scuffle broke out on the dancefloor at Hunter's Jaggers on the R24. What started out as a bump of the shoulder soon turned into a bloody mess. One young man was stabbed in the groin with a knife, and another stabbed in his hand - in-between the throwing of punches. Says Hunter's Jaggers owner Mariette Coetzer: "We try very hard to make this a family establishment. There is no age limit for the shows as parents often want to bring their kids along. We are very sad that this happened at our establishment.

According to lieutenant colonel Amanda Funani: everyone blamed someone else for starting the fight. "We are still trying to understand what really transpired on that night."

An 18 and 20-year-old were taken to hospital with serious injuries. A 17-year-old also opened a common assault case against the 20-year-old.

The 20-year-old was released from hospital and went to open a case of assault with the intent of grievous bodily harm against the 17-year-old. The 18-year-old is still in hospital.

Chicken with tomato sauce (serves four)

Rustenburg/ Tlhabane – Oupa Modise, from Tlhabane, enjoys putting his cooking skills to the test in the kitchen whenever he finds the time.

Chicken with tomato sauce, one of his favourite dishes, is easy to make. Thanks for sharing your recipe, Oupa!

Ingredients:

- 30ml or 2 tablespoons sunflower oil
- 4 chicken quarters
- 1 onion, grated or very finely chopped
- 1 garlic clove, crushed
- 5ml or 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- a good pinch of ground ginger
- 6kg very ripe, sweet tomatoes, peeled, cored and roughly chopped
- 50g blanched almonds
- 1 tablespoon sesame seeds
- salt and ground black pepper
- chopped flat leaf parsley, to garnish

Instructions:

- Heat the oil in a large, flameproof casserole pot and add the chicken. Cook over a medium heat for about 3 minutes until it is lightly browned.
- 2. Add the onion, garlic, cinnamon and ginger.
- Add the tomatoes to the casserole with seasoning to taste and heat gently until the tomatoes bubble.
- 4. Lower the heat and then cover the casserole with a lid. Simmer very gently for about 1 hour, stirring and turning the chicken occasionally, or until it is completely cooked through (pierce the thigh area to check that the meat juices are clear).
- 5. Lift out the chicken pieces and put them in a plate.


