



'We want these people to get paid!'

Rustenburg - The store was forced to close its doors to the public on Wednesday 2 March following a protest. The closure stems from allegations of non-payment of the wages of eight workers who were transferred from Pretoria to Rustenburg.

It is also alleged that some of the workers were instructed to do garden work and not the cleaning jobs they were hired for.

At around 11:00 at the protest, representatives from the Greater Rustenburg Community Forum (GRCF) and South African National Civic Organisation (SANCO) arrived and demanded fair employment conditions.

Guilty Kobua from GRCF told Platinum Weekly: "The workers were not offered proper accommodation when they arrived from Pretoria. Men and women both sleep in the basement and it has been a month now. All we want is for these people to get paid, to get proper accommodation and do the job which they were hired for."

The manager of the supermarket preferred not to comment about the allegations when approached.

Police officers at the scene maintained law and order while the manager engaged with the workers and representatives from GRCF and SANCO for an amicable solution.

Online payment gateway for renewal of driver and vehicle

SA – The Minister of Transport, Fikile Mbalula announced the launch of an online payment gateway for renewal of driver and vehicle licences among other services.

The introduction of online payments means

Although these online services do not eliminate the need for queuing, they have been introduced to improve service delivery and minimise the need for a motorist to visit a DLTC a number of times, said transport minister Fikile Mbalula.

The services include:

Motor vehicle licence renewal

Individuals and corporates will be able to register their accounts online. Once the payment is done, the disc will either be couriered or posted at an additional fee.

Driving licence card renewal

Here is the catch - Even though you will be able to pay prior to going to the licencing department, you still need to go to the licencing department to have your fingerprints taken and your eye test done.

Booking appointment for learner's licences test and driving licence test

Once you have registered online, you can book your appointment.

Rustenburg Court still closed - 😢

Rustenburg - The Rustenburg Magistrates' Court remained closed this week, in line with a directive from the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM).

The municipality ordered the closure of the court on Friday 25 February 2022 following concerns about the poor state of the building as well as unsafe ablution facilities. The ceiling of the building is in a bad state while the toilets need to be refurbished.

Since the directive of the closure, renovations and repairs of the building are yet to be carried out and it is highly likely that cases will be referred to the Bafokeng Magistrates' Court in Tlhabane.

The North West Department of Public Works together with the Department of Justice are engaging with the RLM for a way forward.

Bosch Street Raceway

Rustenburg - The students of Orbit TVET College are fed up with having to dodge and dive oncoming traffic while using the pedestrian crossing in front of the college [Bosch Street].

"My heart always beats faster whenever I cross Bosch street at the pedestrian crossing," student leader Kgotsofatso Simane says. Apparently, it is common for vehicles to 'fly' past the crossing without yielding to students wanting to cross the road.

Simane told Platinum Weekly about a fellow student who had to be rushed to hospital after he was knocked down by a car at the crossing in January 2021. "The driver of the car did not stop." Simane says that in recent weeks, a lot of students using the crossing have also complained of 'near misses' occurring mostly between 7:30am and 8am during peak traffic. "Cars have to give way to pedestrians at or on the crossing, but they don't. It is also a raised crossing, making it more visible, and unsafe for a car to cross at a high speed," Simane says.

It is against this background that traffic along Bosch Street came to a complete standstill on Wednesday 23 February, because of protesting students. The students also demanded the installation of traffic lights and a speed hump close to the crossing. "We cannot safely use this pedestrian crossing," Simane added.

Police and details from the Department of Public Safety diverted traffic from accessing the road as the protestors blocked the road.

The Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) promised to address the concerns of the students. Says RLM spokesperson Thapelo Matebesi: "Member of the Mayoral Committee for roads and transportation councillor Lebogang Pule-Ndou and councillor Virginia Mputle (Public Safety) engaged with TVET College students regarding the need to put up painted speed humps, painted road lanes and deploying scholar patrols, in the interest of students' safety."





Can I cancel an agreement by email?

Rustenburg - The purpose of a contract is to provide legal certainty. A well drafted contract should crystalise the rights and obligations of the contracting parties. In the event of a dispute, the parties should be able to fall back on the terms of the contract to resolve their dispute. It would make little sense to record only parts of an agreement, whilst the rest remains verbal or unrecorded.

Parties should, therefore, ensure that their whole agreement is incorporated in the written document Our courts have accepted the principle that where a contract has been reduced to writing, the recorded document is the exclusive memorial of the agreement.

In pursuit of certainty, it has also become general practice for contracts to contain a 'non-variation clause', also referred to as a 'Shifren clause'. Such a clause will generally provide that "no variation to, or cancellation of the agreement shall be of any force and effect unless reduced to writing and signed by the parties". The clause aims to prevent a situation where parties verbally agreed to amend a contract, and later disagree on the exact extent of their amendment.

In recent times, however, most communications are sent by email. This begs the question of whether an amendment or cancellation, done by email, will satisfy the requirement of 'signed by the parties' as required by a standard non-variation clause.

The Supreme Court of Appeal addressed this question in the case of Spring Forest Trading CC v Wilberry (Pty) Ltd. The relevant facts of the matter were that the parties concluded a written agreement containing a standard non-variation clause. The parties agreed, by way of emails, to cancel the agreement. One of the parties, at a later stage, alleged that the agreement was never validly cancelled because the cancellation was not in writing and not signed by the parties

The party in favour of the cancellation argued that the email signature on the bottom of the emails constituted a valid signature and thereby satisfied the requirement of 'signed by the parties'. The court turned to the Electronic Communications and Transactions Act ("the Act") for an answer.

Section 13(3) of the Act provides that where an electronic signature is required, and the parties do not agree on the type of electronic signature, the requirement is met if

- · a method is used to identify the person and to indicate the person's approval of the information communicated: and
- having regard to all the relevant circumstances at the time the method was used, the method was as reliable as was appropriate for the purposes for which the information was communicated.

Section 13(1) of the Act, however, provides that where a person's signature is required by law and such law does not specify the type of signature, that requirement in relation to a data message is met only if an advanced electronic signature is used.

It is important to note that the Act caters for two types of signatures. The first, is an advanced electronic signature, which is required where the law requires a person's signature. The second, is a standard electronic signature, which is required where the parties, amongst themselves, agree that a signature is required but they do not specify the type of signature required.

The Supreme Court of Appeal held that, in as far as non-variation clauses are concerned, the requirement for a signature is imposed by the parties on themselves

It is, in other words, not a requirement by law and does therefore not require an advanced electronic signature. A standard electronic signature would therefore suffice, provided it meets the two requirements of identification and reliability mentioned above.

The court held that, as long as the 'data' in an email is intended by the user to serve as a signature and is logically connected with other data in the email. the requirement for an electronic signature will be satisfied. This then, so the court said, includes typewritten names of parties at the foot of emails. Should there, however, be a dispute about the reliability of the emails, or the identity of the

person who sent it, the requirement of a valid standard electronic signature will not be met because it will no longer comply with the two requirements therefore be made between cases where the owner of an email account sent the email, and where the email was sent by a hacker.
