Unique solutions kept the wheels of the legal system rolling

Rustenburg Magistrates' Court is back in business.

Rustenburg – The Rustenburg Magistrates' Court has been closed since Friday 25 February due to the Rustenburg Local Municipality's assessment of the health and safety risk of the building to any person who has access to it.

After several weeks of having attorneys arriving at dead man's door, and our local legal processes coming to an almost standstill, alternative plans had to be made. The Legal Practice Council North West Provincial Office ensured that arrangements were made to get the legal processes flowing again. Certain matters were dealt with to keep the judicial system running. The following arrangements were made:

- Criminal Court matters were held at the Rustenburg Police station.
- Civil Court matters were held at the Traffic Department opposite Netcare Ferncrest Hospital.
- Maintenance Court matters were held at Mobile Units currently used by the Office

of the Family Advocate, situated within the Court building.

- Domestic and harassment matters were held at the Office of the Family Advocate.
- Children's Court matters were held at the Office of the Family Advocate.
- Estate and Liquidation and Distribution matters were serviced at the office of the Family Advocate.
- There was a drop off documents' office of the Public Protector next to the Court Building, where the clerks were available to collect.

On 15 March there was a High Court hearing, whereby the court ordered that a meeting should be held between the municipality and representatives from the Minister of Public Works and Infrastructure on 16 March, to reach a consensus on all the conditions at the Rustenburg Magistrates' Court. This meeting proved to be fruitful, as it was business as usual at the court, shortly after.

ATM BOMBING IN RUSTENBURG NORTH

Rustenburg – The owners of a tavern situated in Rustenburg North are still counting their losses after an ABSA ATM next to the tavern was bombed. Police confirmed that the ATM at Cosy Corner was bombed on Tuesday 15 March at around 00:50. "At this stage, we do not know how many suspects were involved as we do not have any eyewitnesses yet," police spokesperson captain Aafjie Botma told *Platinum Weekly*. It is also not yet clear how much money the suspects managed to get away with. An employee at Cosy Corner, said the bombing had adversely affected their business. "Our customers cannot withdraw their money and incidents of this nature always leave people feeling insecure," the manager said.

Admin clerk and learner dies, food poisoning?

Swartruggens – The North West Department of Education is deeply concerned by the death of a 36-year-old Mazista Primary School administration clerk and a 9-year-old learner.

The two died on Friday 4 March from an alleged food poisoning incident in Swartruggens. Another learner, a 16-year-old brother to the 9-year-old was admitted to Job Shimankana Tabane Hospital in Rustenburg after eating the same food that was consumed by the other two victims.

North West Department of Education spokesperson Elias Malindi told *Platinum Weekly* that the alleged food poisoning incident occurred at the home of the administration clerk. "This incident occurred outside the school, after hours," Malindi confirmed. "In instances such as this one, the police will take samples of the food and conduct their investigations. We gave them our full cooperation," he added.

The deaths sparked an outrage from Mazista community members who blocked the entrance to the school. The community, who refused to allow educators and staff members access into or outside the school, eventually dispersed after police intervened and restored calm.

Police spokesperson brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone said inquests into the death of the two are underway.

Powerless in Arnoldistad [Letter to the editor]

Arnoldistad/ Kroondal – Some of Arnoldistad's residents are left powerless after a power outage that lasted more than two weeks.

The first problems with transformers started on Monday 28 February and the second problems with transformers started on 3 March. With phases down, we had just enough electricity to damage a refrigerator but not enough to turn on a light.

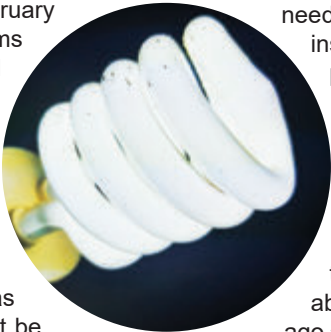
Technical teams visited the area several times, every time with a different excuse as to why the electricity could not be restored. Eventually it "came to light" that the fuses needed to be replaced and that the Rustenburg Local Municipality did not have any in stock.

Residents called the RLM's call centre without end, every time to be disappointed with no concrete feedback.

One of the residents eventually obtained fuses at his own cost, and made arrangements with RLM to install it. When they finally came, they said that the fuses were not the problem. "We have enough fuses... the real problem is the fuse holders"... Urgh! – and they did not have stock and their supplier was waiting for his supplier to send stock...

... and when this will happen is anyone's guess?

Furious and completely at their wits end,



business owners in the area came to the rescue and volunteered to pay for the fuse holders. There was no stock in Rustenburg so they had to buy it in Gauteng.

The fuse holders arrived in Rustenburg on 16 March and the RLM were immediately informed that they have the items needed and that they can come install it. The plea to install the parts were made long before 12:00 but call after call to follow up on the installation were left unanswered. When one resident called the call centre just after 15:00, they were informed by the agent that she was only informed about the incident 30 minutes ago and residents should be patient.

Later we were informed that the team is busy in another area and that they might be there at around 08:00 on 17 March – if this will happen remains to be seen.

RLM communications manager Thapelo Matebesi said electricity engineers attribute frequent power outages to theft and vandalism of infrastructure, tripping of the system, fault on the feeder and explosions. When enough is enough?

Rustenburg – Business owners blocked off the road on the corner of Molen and Joubert street on Friday 11 March. They protested about a power outage in the area since 8 March.

"Since the electricity went out, we've had at least two attempted break-ins at our shop. We are losing money and our pleas are falling on deaf ears, so we are taking a stand," AR & H Springs co-owner Anje Dreyer told *Platinum Weekly*.

The protest was eventually disbanded and traffic in the area started flowing again. Crime is a big concern with the power outages in the area, as other companies also had to sharpen the security to adapt to the dark. Initially, the Rustenburg Local

Municipality (RLM)'s electrical team said that the power was cut off due to non-payment. However, after a follow-up by Democratic Alliance ward 18 councillor Cobus Nortje, it was established that this was not the case. The team then once again came out and established that the mini substations was vandalised and the whole minisub needed to be replaced. After almost a week without electricity, the power was eventually restored on 14 March.

According to RLM communications manager Thapelo Matebesi, electrical engineers attribute frequent power outages to theft and vandalism of infrastructure, tripping of the system, fault on the feeder and explosions of the mini substations.

Rustenburg – As much as they are entertaining, baboons have a mean streak to them that makes them difficult neighbours. They rummage through your garbage, raid your garden and sometimes even hurt your pets.

In a recent incident Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism (DEDECT) damage causing animal official, Vasti Botha was called out to assist when a baboon tried to pull a parrot through its cage.

Baboons often create problems when they invade homes looking for food. They knock over waste containers, steal fruit and vegetables from gardens and cause all kinds of trouble. Feeding the baboons because you feel sorry for them just escalates the problem.

Tips to keep the baboons at bay

There are measures you can put in place to secure your property from being invaded by baboons and monkeys.

- **No feeding!** Please do not feed the baboons or leave rubbish bins where they can be raided by the baboons.
- **Protect your animals.** Baboons are very aggressive and dangerous. It is advised to take your dogs into your house if there are baboons in your yard.
- **Fake snakes...** Botha says: “They are very scared of snakes and the use of plastic toy snakes hanging on a piece of fishing line or being placed on a roof will frighten them away. These toy snakes must be moved around from time to time otherwise the baboons will realise that

they are fake”.

- **Install locks and latches...** You can prevent baboons from entering your home by installing window and door latches. It will allow you to leave windows and doors open while keeping baboons out.
- **Water!** Baboons don’t like water. You can use your hose or a water gun to chase them away as long as you stay at a safe distance.
- **Electric fences...** If you have the budget, electric fences are an effective way to protect your property from baboons.
- **Baboon-proof your dustbins** Dustbins and fruit trees are major attractions for baboons. This problem increases during the winter months when food is scarcer. Baboons love the leftovers you throw away. Try and separate your organic garbage into a separate container that you can put out of reach of the baboons.

SAFETY 1ST!

If you encounter a troop of baboons on your property: stand still and remain calm, be confident, back away slowly and don’t try to snatch anything back from the thieving scoundrels. Baboons can be a serious danger to people and should not be underestimated, especially, if they feel they have to protect their babies or a source of food.

Unfortunately, lethal control is sometimes needed, and the department will only shoot individual damage causing baboons and make use of a professional hunter to ensure that this is done in an ethical manner.

Killing our beautiful bushveld, one tree at a time



Rustenburg – Please take extra care when buying firewood next to the road – make sure that the wood was harvested responsibly.

A beautiful piece of the protected Magaliesberg Biosphere is being targeted by tree fellers trying to make a quick buck from selling firewood. Please don’t support their crime by buying any firewood from them.

Platinum Weekly spoke to doctor Cathy Dzerefos who serves as a director on the Magaliesberg Biosphere Board who said: “The felling of Boekenhout, African stinkwood, thorn trees and even the marula in the Rietvlei area are tragic on several levels. Rustenburg residents often have wood from their gardens and pavements that they would gladly have the wood collectors take for use as firewood.

“Just this weekend the Change Agents that have been planting trees and keeping the area at Fontein street behind Kenny Gee’s clean, were so saddened by someone who just dumped a tree that was cut up.

We really have let those kids down by disrespecting their efforts. What a shame that the wood cutters can’t take this wood instead of chopping down live indigenous trees.

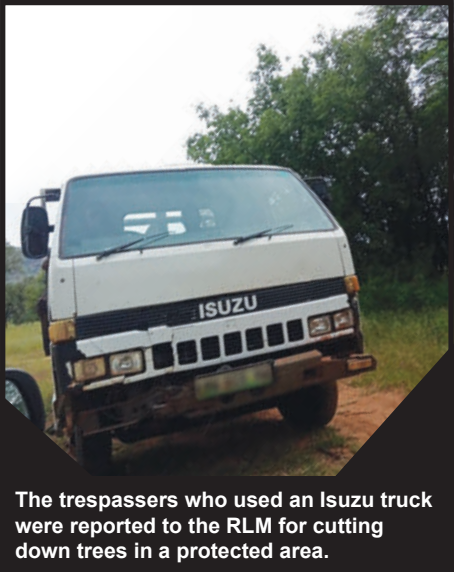
“In Haenertsburg Limpopo, ZZ2 are taking offcuts from people’s gardens and making compost. We should do things better! We just need people in authority and in functional businesses to think a little harder about things other than money. It’s not just the trees that are being lost but a whole ecosystem that relies on those trees.

“We have people at municipal and provincial level that are being paid to protect our biodiversity. This matter has been reported to them so why are they not doing something? All I can say is that at some point they will be held to account and till then I hope they feel a little bit ashamed as they drive past the destruction that is happening on their watch.”

The area (which forms part of the Magaliesberg Biosphere) between King’s Gate Hotel and the piece of land where people are often evicted on the N4 is targeted by these tree fellers. Most of the property belongs to the Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM).

Many of the trees are also protected species.

In one of the latest incidents the trespassers were confronted by Dawid Erasmus who lives in the area. He took photos of their Isuzu truck and numberplate and reported the incident to the RLM and his councillor Johan Cronje, who also reported the incident. Erasmus is still awaiting feedback from the RLM...

Rustenburg – Centre for Hope Church bishop Jeffrey Mogapi has made it his mission to help put as many young people as possible living in Dinie Estates on the straight and narrow.

As the name of the church he established in 2019 suggests, bringing hope to the community is central to his ministry, which seeks to discourage young people from engaging in activities such as illegal drugs and alcohol abuse.

In an interview with *Platinum Weekly*, the 44-year-old Mogapi asked for businesses or any well-wishers to assist the church to purchase instruments.

Born at Redcliff Farm, Mogapi attended Redcliff Farm Primary School before proceeding to Raphurele High School in Moruleng. Mogapi’s grandfather was also a bishop.

“After school I worked in the mines and the taxi industry as a driver. After moving to Dinie Estates in 2015, we started our own prayer group at my house and this became the foundation upon which our church was established,” he added.

He said young people living in Dinie Estates do not have local recreational facilities. He also expressed concern at the many teenage girls who often fail to continue with their academic career after a pregnancy.

“I am raising money to buy instruments for our church. We want the youth to be involved, and are also including the youngsters in our choir,” he said. Mogapi said their church is in need of drums, speakers, guitars and keyboards.

If you are still sceptical about the ability of Sundowns to go all the way and win the league title, then perhaps you did not watch how they managed to fend off Egyptian giants Ahl Ahly with a 1-0 win in the CAF Champions League. In fact, most of the talk in local football circles nowadays – and rightfully so – is no longer about the team likely to be crowned PSL champions. Rather, it revolves around which of the two teams between Royal AM and Kaizer Chiefs are likely to achieve a second-place finish on the log. Attention has also shifted to whether or not Sundowns striker Peter Shalulile is capable of winning the top scorer award this season. The PSL top goal scorer award, also known as the 'Lesley

Manyathela Golden Boot', is awarded to the player who finishes the season with the highest number of goals. Rustenburg – Doctor Emmanuel Taban wrote the book *'The boy who never gave up'*. The story of his life inspired the learners at Hoërskool Rustenburg. It gave them a unique look at the realities of life beyond school but also gave them the assurance that a person can rise above their circumstances. According to Taban, nothing worthwhile, comes easy. When he addressed the learners on Monday 14 March he said: "Success is only possible after a lot of tribulation and hardship. The future is yours. Find it within yourself to have integrity and make it part of your DNA." He shared his harrowing journey from war-torn Sudan to South Africa. Doctor Taban was born in Sudan. At the young age of 16, he was abducted and tortured by Sudanese troops who accused him of being a rebel spy. He eventually managed to escape on foot, intending to go back home, but somehow, due to circumstances out of his control, he ended up in another country. That is when he

decided to take charge of his life, no matter what he faces along the way. After traveling for months, often spending weeks on the streets, facing various dangers and relying on the generosity of strangers, he arrived in Johannesburg just before his 18th birthday. He was determined to complete his schooling and with the help of Catholic missionaries he got his matric, finished his basic medical degree at Sefako Makgatho Health Science University [previously known as MEDUNSA] after which he furthered his studies, specialising in pulmonology. When Covid-19 struck in 2020 his special skills were in high demand, and he fought on the frontline against the viral disease. His pioneering work in treating Covid-19 also earned him the title of 'Africa Person of the Year 2022'.

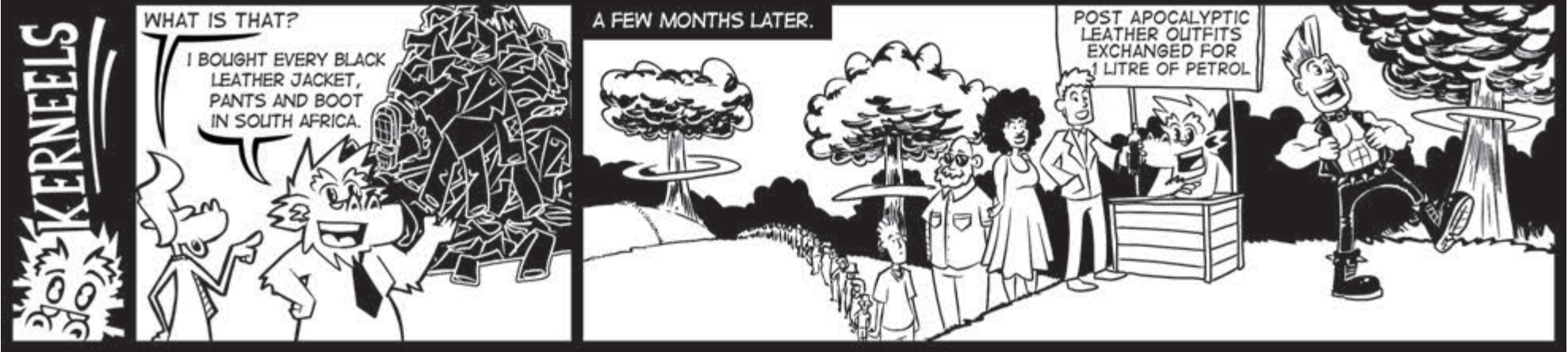
